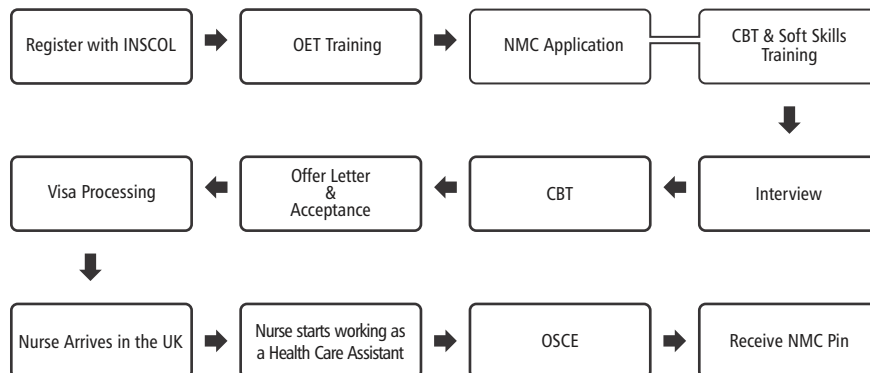
Eligibility Criteria

- Registered Nurse with BSc Nursing / GNM
- Clinical experience of at least 6 months post-registration within last 18 months
- Language Proficiency:
OET = B in S, R, L & C+ in W
OR
IELTS 7 in S, R, L & 6.5 in W
(Clubbing is allowed)*
